छत्तीसगढ़ का बेमेतरा जिला



बेमेतरा जिला भारत के छत्तीसगढ़ राज्य में एक नया है । रमन सिंह ने 13 जनवरी 2015 को बेमेतरा जिला को पूर्ण रूप से घोषित किया । श्रुति सिंह आईएएस का पहला कलेक्टर और जिला मजिस्ट्रेट बन गया । बेमेतरा में दो प्रशासनिक उपविभाग हैं बेमेतरा और साजा । बेमेतरा का वर्तमान कलेक्टर श्री महादेव कंवर हैं । इसमें तीन ब्लॉक हैं साजा नवागढ़ व बेमेतरा हैं ।

जिले के सभी 700 आबाद गावों का विद्युतीकरण हो चुका है । बेमेतरा नगर की जनसंख्या 2011 की जनगणना के हिसाब से 28226 है । बेमेतरा जिला शिवनाथ, सुरही हाफ और सकरी नदी के प्रवाह क्षेत्र में आता है ।

पर्यटन – बेमेतरा नगर में स्थित सिद्ध शक्तिपीठ माता भद्रकाली व माता शीतला के मंदिर प्रसिद्ध है । बेमेतरा से 15 कि.मी. दूरी पर स्थित देवरबीजा ग्राम पर स्थित सीता मंदिर और रायपुर जिले के सरहद में शिवनाथ व खारून नदी के संगम में अत्यंत रमणीय व धार्मिक पर्यटन स्थल सोमनाथ का मंदिर इस जिले की शोभा बढ़ाते हैं । यहाँ के कलेक्टर भवन का निर्माण बहुत आकर्षित व सुंदर बनायी गयी है । बेमेतरा जिला अभी अपने शैशवावस्था है ।

इसमें अभी कई शिक्षण संस्थान – स्कूल और कॉलेज और सरकारी संस्थानों की आवश्यकता है ।

FOCUS ON QUALITY



RTE Failed student through piecemeal non-detention. Don't punish them again by piecemeal reform. With Parliament passing the Right to Education (RTE) Amendment bill that scraps the controversial non-detention policy, the mistakes of the RTE Act must not be repeated. Its heavy emphasis on inputs like physical infrastructure in school, matter that on qualitative outcomes like learning levels and teaching standards was misplaced. Alongside no detention, the original RTE Mandated rigorous Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) of children in school.

While children were casually promoted forward, CCE which would have required a comprehensive systemic overhaul fell by the wayside. And now when detention of students returns to our education policy complacency must not set in under the cavalier assumption that the fear of failure will prompt children to study with renewed vigour.

Unfortunately, many teachers have made their way into the education system without requisite qualification or teaching skill and then enjoy security of tenure that doesn't weed out non-performance. In 2016, Centre had reported that government school faced a shortfall of 10 lakh teachers, with vacancies touching 22% and 34%. Respectively in pivotal states like Uttar Pradesh and Bihar. For a start in the sector recruit the Best teacher for these vacancies, especially when India now has a large army of "Overqualified". Jobseekers who apply despectly even for group-D/Class-IV Jobs in government.

HRD Minister Prakash Javedekar assured sceptical Rajya Sabha. MP's that dropouts will not spike despite detention of failing students. As per ASER survey & 86% student enroll in formal education where, 25% of in this age group (14-18 age group) being unable to read fluently & 50% having problem doing Basic Maths and reading English. Therefore Javedekar's assurance to hold on the dropouts and assure the confidence of parents and students in education. This is where school must show improvement in teaching and learning outcomes. The discourse must more move forward from universal access to right to quality education, not backward to increasing dropouts.
